INTRODUCTION

Floods are not a new phenomenon in Pakistan. There have been 50 floods in the last 28 years. While recent floods in Pakistan is the worst incident which have killed over 1,600 people, left two million homeless, washed away crops and farm animals.

These all Alliances are led by HRDN. HRDN through its alliance members plan and organize together for immediate actions to combat emergencies. They put in the collaborative efforts by involving communities, partners and all stakeholders for effective and efficient disaster response. Currently, Alliance is working

in Khyber Pakthunkhwa, South Punjab, Sindh, and Swat. The alliance has taken several steps in reaching to the affectees who are still inaccessible.

EFFORTS OF HRDN AND PHA MEMBERS:

PHA is led by Human Resource Development Network. HRDN together with its alliance members is contributing towards relief, recovery and rehabilitation of flood victims in Pakistan. All the member organizations are playing their part in their respective geographic areas.

HRDN arrange relief activities to trim down the miseries of flood disaster affected people. Free medical camp was arranged at Pir Mahwal, Deh Nakur Union Council Hamal Faqir Laghari by RDF organization. As of September 1, Rawadari's Medical

Teams have treated total 18, 296 patients suffering from different water born diseases.

HRDN team visited Charsada, Esa Khel-Mianwali, Beshigram-Swat and Layyah to distribute food items for 4984 beneficiaries. Moreover, HRDN intends to establish medical camp in consultation with the local doctors of District Mianwali.

The next plans are to organize medical camps in villages of D. I. Khan, South Punjab where skin and stomach diseases are so common in the poor community who are bound to survive in the stagnant waters. People there are dying with Gastro. It is the most important need area to be touched. This is all from the individual contributions, our valued members and friends.

We are continuing these efforts, as we continue to get more donations and funds. The need is big and the scale of disaster is huge. Any such support is possible with the generous donations and kind help of HRDN valued members who contributed a lot in the form of cash and kind in this crucial time. HRDN members are standing together with each other. Special thanks to those who have served as volunteers and contributed towards this cause.
